

NCUEA CONSTITUTIONAL ADMENDMENT

Article IX-NOMINATIONS, BALLOTING AND ELECTIONS

Section 2: Nominations

Each candidate must submit a letter of nomination from his/her member association to the elections chairperson. The letter of nomination must ~~state~~ include the minutes of the meeting when the official action of support was taken by the NCUEA member association board of directors and must be signed by the chair of said action or the NCUEA member association's president. The letter of nomination must be emailed (date-stamped) or postmarked ~~by~~ between Sept 1 and May 1st prior to the election, by the governing body of the candidate's NCUEA member association for the year of the election and or appointment.

Rationale: NCUEA EC candidates need to be supported by the NCUEA member association's governance team from the year that they are running. Including the minutes has been a past practice and this explicitly calls for it.
