GETTING READY: ASSESS STRENGTHS & OPPORTUNITIES

- Working organizational structures such as building reps
- Ability to communicate with members
- Supportive, engaged leadership
- Bylaws that allow for spending of money on politics, recommending candidates, etc.
- Money that can be spent on member education/engagement and political activities – different dollars!

Local Dues/General Fund Dollars

STEP 1: PROJECTED TURNOUT %




 There are currently 66,908 registered voters in the district





EXERCISE BREAKDOWN

Year	Turnout	Registration	%
2020	42,630	62,897	68%
2016	38,976	58,907	66%
2012	30,876	55,876	55%



(68+66+55)/3 = 63% is projected turnout %

66,908 registered voters x 63% = 42,152 is the <u>projected voter</u> <u>turnout</u>

2 candidate race: $42,152 \times 52\% = 21,919$



HOW TO USE VOTE GOAL

- Ask candidate if they have vote goal, they will need a measureable goal to reach for their voters: How many calls, conversations, mailing universe size do they need?
- Give your candidate strategic field knowledge
- Help the local realize the numbers they can deliver for the candidate



 - All have at least 1 opponent


















OUR PROGRAM
